Laurence Juber

Dwayne Cote & Duane Andrews

Using folk, jazz, and pop styles, two-time Grammy-winner **Laurence Juber** creates a multifaceted performance that belies the use of only one acoustic guitar. The lead guitarist for **Paul McCartney's Wings** (with whom he earned a Grammy award), Juber is a world-renowned guitar virtuoso, composer and arranger.

He has released 20 solo albums of which the latest, **Soul of Light**, is a newly recorded retrospective collection of 30 years of his original compositions. Juber's solo arrangement of **The Pink Panther** earned him a second Grammy. His **L J Plays The Beatles**, was voted one of **Acoustic Guitar Magazine's** all-time Top Ten albums. We are still putting the finishing touches on these events, but the artists will include most if not all of the following: **Great Lake Swimmers, The Be Good Tanyas, Harry Manx, Jim Byrnes & Steve Dawson, Headwater, The Breakmen, Cousin Harley, The Sojourners, Pied Pumkin, Celso Machado, Khac Chi, Zaac Pick**, and more!

We present Nova Scotia's **Laura Smith** at St. James Hall on **August 3rd**, and also have one or two nights at **CBC Studio 700: Linda McRae's CD Launch on August 7th**, and a possible double-bill with **Joy Kills Sorrow** and **The Fretless** the following night! Then we're off to **Edmonton** for the **Rolls Royce of Music Festivals** (August 9th to 12th) before taking another well-earned break for a few weeks.

The Fall Season will likely kick off with **Eilen Jewell** on August 31st. We'll have a CD Launch for **The Bills** on September 7th, and later in the month we present the return of Scotland's **Paul McKenna Band** (22nd) and **Don Ross & Brooke Miller** (28th.) October is always a busy month at The Rogue, and this year we have Irish band **Comas** (4th), Geordie songwriter **Jez Lowe** (5th), **Ray Bonneville** (7th), **Fatoumata Diawara** (date tba), **Oysterband** (19th), **Dala** (21st), **James Keelaghan** (26th), **Stacey Earle & Mark Stuart** (27th), and **BettySoo & Doug Cox** (30th.) Looking further ahead, we hope to have **Lunasa** and Louisiana's **Mamou Playboys** in early November, and then **Debashish Bhattacharya** (6th), **Madison Violet** (16th) and a **Mad Pudding** Reunion (17th). We're also working on a PBHS co-presentation of the **Kathy Kallick Band** and the return of Quebec's **Genticorum**. In April 2013 we'll bring **The Savoy Cajun Band** to St. James Hall for a Cajun Dance (April 4th), then **April In Paris** (April 12-14), and **Taj Mahal**

to **The Chan Centre** (April 25th)! At the time of writing many of these shows have yet to be confirmed, but we will have another issue of the Review out in time for the VFMF in July, and more details will be included there. Meanwhile, the principal purpose of this edition is to remind you of our June 5th concert with **Old Man Luedecke** and **Del Barber**, the July 5th concert with **Laurence Juber**, and our wonderful annual **Special Deals For Rogues** on Early Bird Tickets for the **Vancouver** and **Mission Folk Music Festivals** (see pages 4&5). In order to take advantage of these deals you need to be a fully paid up member of the Rogue Folk Club, so look for an email reminder from us (and / or Ticket Turtle) if your membership is due for renewal. Laura Smith is a Canadian folk singer-songwriter with a remarkably rich and distinctive voice. She is best known for her 1995 single "Shade of Your Love", one of the year's biggest hits on adult contemporary radio stations in Canada, and for her adaptation of the Scottish folk song "My Bonnie Lies over the Ocean" which she entitled "My Bonny". She has received several nationally recognized awards for her music.

Born and raised in London, Ontario, Smith was encouraged in her early writing by the noted poet Margaret Avison, then writer-in-residence at the University of Western Ontario. She began playing music as well, making her debut in area coffeehouses. She briefly moved to Toronto in 1972, but soon moved to Cape Breton.

Smith released her debut album in 1989. Her second album, **B'tween the Earth and My Soul** (1996) brought her national acclaim and earned her two East Coast Music Awards (Female Artist, Album of the Year) and two Juno nominations. The next year, 1997, she received a Gemini Award.

She continued to work through the 2000s including two seasons on stage in role of Marilla in **Anne and Gilbert**, the Musical at the Confederation Centre of the Arts, Charlottetown. However through the decade she suffered three debilitating accidents which resulted in chronic pain. This led to the use of increasingly stronger prescription drugs which eventually led to dependence. She disappeared from the music

Rough Edges & Ragged Hearts, Linda McRae's highly anticipated fourth solo release doesn't describe the gold and platinum polish enhancing a musical career spanning 25 years. The wonderfully soulful new CD features performances by Gurf Morlix, Ray Bonneville, Doug Cox, Stephen Nikleva, Samantha Parton (Be Good Tanyas), and The Sojourners and affirms Linda's maturing distinction as a quality songwriter and unique performer. It is at once as traditional as a sepia photograph and as current as a viral You Tube song!

Linda earned a Juno nomination and double Platinum triple Gold recording status as bassist and accordionist with Celtic/Roots group Spirit of the West. Departing the band after eight years she

scene for a time, but by 2010, she was performing again, having overcome her dependency through the adoption of non-narcotic pain treatment therapies. Her story was featured in a radio documentary which aired on **CBC Radio One's** morning program **The Current** on February 3, 2010. Since then she has performed numerous shows across Canada, touring with Ryan MacGrath.

We last presented Laura - with Susan Crowe and Raylene Rankin - at Cap a few years ago, and it has been almost 20 years since she last played a solo gig at The Rogue. We are thrilled to have her back!

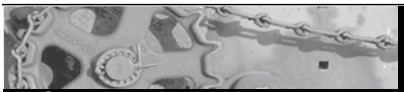

Fatoumata Diawara - Fatou - World Circuit

Mali seems to produce a surfeit of superb musicians, and Mlle is no exception. Already known in West Africa as an actress, she honed her musical skills working with numerous established players, including a stint with living legend **Oumou Sangare**. Fatoumata sings backup on Oumou's '**Seya**', and toured with the incomparable star just a few years ago.

On '**Fatou**', Diawara lays her own cards on the table, and what a potent hand she plays. Great voice, fabulous songs, engaged themes, instinctive musicianship, resonant touch, original songs, this girl has it all.

The styles vary a bit on this electric folio, yet the mood stays consistent, and throughout the often hard-edged themes the songs glide marvelously along in the soft waves of her largely easygoing approach. Certain phrasings and inflections echo the influence of Sangare, understandable and laudable as that is.

Rich tones and melodies abound. Fatoumata reveals a rare talent, earthy yet graceful, spirited yet thoughtful, and all delivered with an inspired touch.

Rogue Album of the Month

Diawara has a thoughtful bent too, discussing potent, relevant themes such as frustrated love, motherhood, living as an orphan, obesity, genital mutilation, the price of individuality, and also slips in reassuring support for and homage to her great mentor Sangare.

From the first fluid riff to the last absorbing melody she captivates completely. A Wassoulou from the southern regions, she sings in West African dialects, yet her vibe and lyrical music has a universal appeal. The booklet with the CD features translations of the lyrics into French and English.

An excellent team of backup musicians provides a rich setting too, with infectious rhythms and inspired soloing, particularly the fluid guitar flourishes from a couple of six string aces.

This is a great debut from a rising star. Locally it is unavailable, yet it is possible to order a copy through Amazon, which takes about 2 weeks to arrive from a shipping origin in the USA.

What a voice, so expressive and disarmingly sympathetic. A stellar songwriter and performer, Diawara seems a star of the near future, and even now a force to be reckoned with. If you have ever considered listening to West African music, this would be a good one with which to open your account.

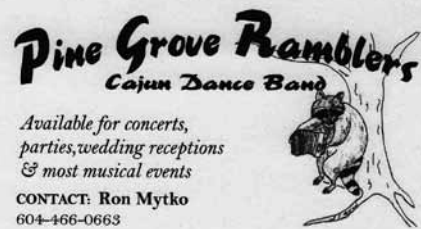
